CHECKLIST

AROUND THE HOUSE

- ✓ Store sunscreen and insect repellents, including sprays, creams, wipes, candles, and other products out of pet's reach.
- ✓ Keep all medications, human and pet, in closed cabinets your pet cannot access
- ✓ Secure pool chemicals in a locked or latched storage area

IN THE YARD

- ✓ Check fertilizer, herbicide, and pesticide labels before use and keep pets off treated areas until dry
- ✓ Know which plants are in your yard. For example, sago palm, oleander, and azalea are toxic to pets

IF SOMETHING HAPPENS

- ✓ Stay calm. Do not attempt to treat your pet at home without guidance
